How to get there: three minutes walking distance from underground station Dahlem Dorf

- **From Berlin Schönefeld (SXF):** one option is to take non-stop bus X7 from the airport to underground station Rudow, then underground line U7 (direction: Rathaus Spandau), changing at Fehrberliner Platz to line U3 (direction: Krumme Lanke), arriving at Dahlem Dorf after about 70 minutes. You will need a ticket for zones ABC.
- **From Berlin Tegel (TXL):** one option is to take bus X9 from the airport to underground station Jakob-Kaiser-Platz, then underground line U7 (direction: Rudow), changing at Fehrberliner Platz to line U3 (direction: Krumme Lanke), arriving at Dahlem Dorf after about 40 minutes. You will need a ticket for zones AB.
